Frequently Asked Questions

- ♦ Is there any homework?
 - ♦ YES! Each quarter students have an Outside Reading Assignment. This is usually a project that is given VERY LITTLE class time to work on. Students MUST be reading and working on their outside reading projects THROUGHOUT the quarter outside of the classroom. See the class website for information on the current outside reading project. Most class assignments, however, are completed in class.
- Is there any extra credit?
 - Generally speaking, I do not offer extra credit. There may be times where I offer bonus points but instead of offering extra credit, I allow students to redo most, if not all, assignments they scored low marks on. Please keep a close eye on PowerSchool and monitor your grades constantly. Also, DO NOT throw away any graded assignments. I have had grades in my gradebook disappear before and your graded assignment is your ONLY proof that you completed the assignment PowerSchool says is missing. Without the proof, you will have to redo the assignment. SAVE YOUR WORK!
- ♦ I'm confused in class/I missed class, can I have help to get caught up?
 - Studyback after school from 3-3:30 Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays is always an option.
