A good Choose Your Own Adventure Story has a...

<p>Strong Introduction:</p> <p>Attention grabber - Hook Background information situates the reader with the topic Setting that “sets the scene”</p>
<p>Character Development and Role Choices:</p> <p>Establish who your characters are At least 2 role choices</p>
<p>Story Elements:</p> <p>Setting established for each role – especially if different from the introduction Kickoff/Catalyst clear and related to the plans (first choice after role establishment) Dialogue Logical story elements – Plausible story line 8th grade appropriate writing</p>
<p>Sequence of Events – Story Paths:</p> <p>At least 2 different opportunities for characters to choose a path Plausible story line – Events happen in a logical order Realistic transitions – Must have natural flow Each story line must have a resolution/ending of its own.</p>
<p>Conclusion:</p> <p>Generalization of the entire topic – not specific to ANY ONE role in the story So what? Now what?</p>
